Prayer for Persecuted Christians: Christianity is reportedly growing in China, with some estimates putting the number of Chinese Christians at over 70 million. In recent years persecution by China's ruling Communist Party has also intensified. Church attendance and religious instruction for anyone under 18 are prohibited. Access to Bibles is severely restricted, as is Christian content on the Internet. The authorities have stepped up efforts to disrupt the house churches in which many Chinese Christians worship. Some Christian leaders have been imprisoned or forcibly disappeared. This month as many American churches mark the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church, we should remember and pray for our fellow Christians who suffer persecution in China and elsewhere. Steve Snow (snow2@erols.com; 616-209-5656), who worked on religious freedom for the U.S. State Department (https://www.state.gov/about-us-office-of-international-religious-freedom/) and the U.S. Commission on International Religious Freedom (https://www.uscirf.gov/), welcomes questions on religious persecution and on efforts to promote religious freedom around the world.
